



RADIO CONTROL BOATS & SIMILAR ACTIVITIES

FRANK G. BONELLI PARK - PUDDINGSTONE LAKE



- 1. Radio controlled boats may only be operated in the Sailboat Cove area and the adjacent waters west of the white pin-buoys heading N/W across the lake. This special-use area is for float tubes, boats less than 8 feet, and experimental vessels that have secured prior park approval.**
 - All R/C operators must be mindful and courteous to all other vessels and anglers (fisherman) in the area.
 - Operators are responsible for the retrieval, actions, and damage of, or caused by their own R/C vessels.

- 2. Radio Controlled sailboats and electric boats powered with batteries:**
 - May operate from sunrise to sunset in the special use area.
 - Must have the ability to return to shore under their own power/sail

- 3. Radio Controlled boats powered by liquid fuel or gas:**
 - The operation of gas powered R/C boats is limited to the hours from 10:00 am to one half hour before sunset.
 - Fuel or gas powered R/C boats are prohibited on Memorial Day, Fourth of July and Labor Day holiday/weekends.
 - A “chase boat” or similar vessel is required, and must be of legal size, meet the requirements of (life preservers, etc.), and display a current launch permit.
 - The “chase boat” must remain present during the operation of the R/C boat.
 - Model boat refueling must be done in the parking lot, and not in the water or along the shoreline.

- 4. All other types of R/C vessels are subject to prior Park approval.**

- 5. Any kind of Model airplanes, model rockets, or kite flying is prohibited at Bonelli Park, due to the proximity of Brackett Airport (LACo. Code Title 13.14.010).**

- 6. Park management reserves the right to eject, restrict or relocate any R/C vessel that may interfere with the Park operations and/or public enjoyment.**
